



Heart Bar/Fish Creek Outing September 19 – 20, 2009

GETTING THERE:

- Meet at St. Matthews Church at 6:30 AM on Saturday morning. Class “B” t-shirt – do not wear your uniform. Cost is \$5 per scout, plus patrol food.

NOTE: The parking lot at the church is being repaved; please meet across Potrero Rd in the dirt lot at the end of Wendy Drive, across from the church.

- Drive to Heart Bar Campground in the San Bernardino National Forest above Redlands, CA.
Driving Directions: 101 Fwy south to 134 Fwy east to 210 Fwy east through San Bernardino to 10 Fwy east to Orange Ave exit in Redlands; take Orange Ave north to Lugonia Ave (Hwy 38) and turn right (east). Follow Hwy 38 about 30 miles into the mountains (past Barton Flats) to Forest Service Road 1N02. Turn right on 1N02 and go ¼ mile to the campground. Troop will provide Adventure Passes for vehicles shuttling people to the Aspen Grove Trailhead for the day hike.

ACTIVITIES:

- Day hike on the Fish Creek Trail to Fish Creek Meadows and back. This is an opportunity to do the 5-mile map/compass hike for 2nd Class rank.
- Work on scout skills, advancement, and just have fun.
- Troop flashlight “campfire” Saturday night – each patrol should be prepared with skits/songs.

MEALS:

- Patrol meals for Saturday lunch and dinner and Sunday breakfast. Scouts should bring money for Sunday lunch along the way home. **Note:** This is a great outing to complete 1st Class cooking requirements!

EQUIPMENT:

- Please refer to the *Troop 730 Recommended Packing List* on the website (www.bsatroop730.org). There is running water at Heart Bar Campground. Tents are required for scouts under 1st Class. Check with your Patrol Leader if you have questions on equipment.

RETURNING HOME:

- Leave for home ~10:30 AM on Sunday. Scouts should bring money for lunch along the way home. We should arrive home ~1:30 PM.
