Meet: St. Mathew’s parking lot **Friday Afternoon at 4:30 pm**

Return: Scouts will be returned to their homes late morning on Sunday; approx 11:00 a.m.

Where: The Walnut Grove at Tierra Rejada Ranch, 3570 Sunset Valley Road, Moorpark, CA

What: The 2010 Conejo Valley District Camporee. Throughout Saturday our patrols will be competing against patrols from the other troops in the district in events ranging from “21st Century Flames” to “Disaster Clinic 2010.” The Camporee is put on for the benefit of our Scouts to demonstrate their skills and knowledge, meet other scouts from around the district, and to have fun doing so. All units attending will co-host an event. Our troop will be hosting the Centurion Chariot Race event this year.

Food: Sack dinner/snack on Friday evening

Patrol cooking for Saturday breakfast & dinner and Sunday breakfast.

Troop lunch on Saturday will be provided for everyone by the adults to allow scouts maximum time to compete in events.

Adult meals will be arranged separately from the scouts

Uniforms: **Full CLASS A uniform is required for: Friday check-in (uniform inspection), Saturday morning assembly, Saturday evening Campfire, and Sunday morning assembly.** At all other times the activity uniform is ‘class B’.

Scout Store: A Scout Store will be open during Camporee to allow purchase of water, soda and candy.

Equipment: Patrol leaders have information on required patrol equipment. For personal equipment, please see the recommended packing list on the troop website.

Note: Anything you bring with you Friday PM will need to be carried from the parking lot.

PATROL LEADERS - There will be a truck/trailer taking heavy gear (e.g., Patrol boxes) early in the day on Friday. If you care to take advantage of this, contact Mr. McVey and make arrangements to get your gear on board.

Notes for parents/family members:

- 1) We are looking for potential drivers for drop-off and pick-up. Please let Mr. Meisner know if you would be available for Friday evening or Sunday morning.
- 2) On Saturday, you may come as spectators during the events, as well as attend the campfire.
